Essential Duties

- Understanding and abiding by the Waterfront Operating Procedures
- Ensure that guests experience, a safe, enjoyable and well organised waterfront experience
- Running the beach on a rota system, and constantly being aware of the safety of guests, and that they are being looked after and well served
- Working under the Waterfront and Assistant Waterfront Manager to have a professional, guest focused waterfront, serving the guest experience in valuing every guest that wants to engage in the waterfront.
- Running courses and sessions within your qualifications and capabilities
- Take time for personal sailing progression and further training as guided by the Waterfront Manager throughout the season
- Helping to coach and develop waterfront instructors and Fast Trackers
- Ensure that kit is well looked after and maintained, undertaking simple repair jobs as instructed by the waterfront manager
- Join in with life in resort including being involved with evening and daytime entertainments as required and dealing with guest inquiries and queries where possible, remembering that even in “down time” you are representing Richmond.
- Partake in guest dinners, eating with them and socialising with them in order to create and develop an exceptionally warm and welcoming atmosphere
- Commit to taking regular times of prayer and bible study in order to maintain a living and active relationship with God. To be looking to advance your journey as a Christian, wherever you feel you are at the start of your role.
