Job Responsibilities

1. Relational and Practical Support for Chalet Operations

- The key focus of the role is to have a guest-focused approach and be willing to undertake any
 requests from guests and the wider team at any time, remembering that even on your time off
 you are on duty and representing Richmond
- Create and deliver an exceptionally warm and welcoming atmosphere, remaining interruptible and available to guests and building relationships in a genuine and authentic manner
- Actively make conversation with guests during activities, mealtimes, afternoon tea and any given opportunity
- Run the evening entertainment programme on a rota system, with creativity and enthusiasm.
- Lead in serving meals and afternoon tea, manage the breakfast buffet, clear meals, serve behind the bar, potwash. Responsibility for presentation, preparation and food hygiene measures in all food service
- Assist in the kitchen e.g. cooking breakfast, baking cakes, preparing ingredients for evening meals as required
- Clean rooms and public areas of the chalet to a high standard, including the exterior, keeping access routes clear from snow and ice
- Maintaining the spa facilities and taking ownership of the presentation and technical aspects of the sauna and hot tubs
- Providing age-appropriate children's games and children's tea as required for under 12s
- Comply with all Richmond policies and procedures and Health & Safety regulations

2. Transfer Driving and Vehicle Management

- Transfer driving from the chalet to bus stations, train stations and airports in a 9 seater minibus, in various weather conditions with our guests. Provide safe and professional driving, hosting our guests well in a well-presented vehicle
- Where required, make additional exceptional journeys in snowy conditions
- Complete a weekly cleaning to a high standard and safety check for the vehicles, ensuring they are ready for changeover day each week

- Partake in guest dinners, eating with them and socialising with them in order to create and develop an exceptionally warm and welcoming atmosphere
